

### Our Teacher and Instructor: A. B. Simpson

Albert Benjamin Simpson (1843-1919) is known as one of the most respected Christian figures in



American evangelicalism. Simpson founded a major evangelical denomination and pastored churches in Hamilton, Canada, Louisville, Kentucky and New York City. Simpson was a prolific writer from the start of his ministry, having authored many Christian classics and countless hymns, periodicals, articles, and curriculums over his lifetime. He wrote "Walking in the Spirit" in the late 1800's which serves as the base text for this study. Simpson's influence went on to move the hearts of missionaries, pastors, and people of all denominations towards

spreading the gospel all over the world.

#### The Panel

#### **Francois Fenelon**



Francois de Salignac de la Mothe-Fenelon (1651-1715) was a French Roman Catholic archbishop, theologian poet and writer. Fenelon, as he became known, wrote the classic "Christian Counsel" near the end of the 17<sup>th</sup> century. "The Seeking Heart," also quoted in this study was compiled from His works and letters and ring profoundly true in modern times.

#### A.W. Tozer



Aiden Wilson Tozer (1897-1963) served for over 40 years as a minister in the Christian and Missionary Alliance including 31 years at the Southside Alliance Church in Chicago. A proponent of Modern Fundamentalism, Tozer reached beyond any particular denomination focusing on prayer, worship and a deeper life in Christ. Tozer wrote three of the books referenced in this study including "The Crucified Life," "The Pursuit of God," and "The Knowledge of the Holy."

#### John Wesley



Johnathan Wesley (1703-1791) was an Anglican clergyman, evangelist, and founder, with his brother Charles, of the Methodist movement in the Church of England. Wesley taught salvation through grace but also sanctification throughout the life of a Christian. Wesley's classic "A Plain Account of Christian Perfection" is quoted frequently in the study along with quotes from numerous speeches and sermons in the 18<sup>th</sup> century.

#### **Charles Stanley**



Charles Frazier Stanley (1932-Present) pastored Baptist churches in North Carolina, Ohio and Florida before being named Senior Pastor of the First Baptist Church in Atlanta, GA. Stanley is a best-selling author and wrote "The Wonderful Spirit Filled Life" providing practical modern day advice to those seeking a deeper life. Stanley established In Touch Ministries in 1982. His broadcasts are translated into 100 languages.
